Much of my research foregrounds sexual diversity and queer concerns such as stigma and selfdisclosure. I have written about the nuances of disclosing same gender attraction—often referred to as "coming out (of the closet)." I have described experiences of sexuality before, during, and after coming out, as well as demonstrated how the coming-out process never ends as every new audience makes for a new time to disclose one's likes and desires. I have studied queer bars, media representations, and fetish communities, as well as how queer folks live with others who commit homophobic and transphobic slights. I have also prioritized building an interdisciplinary and international infrastructure for autoethnography, a method that merges the practices of life writing with the practices of ethnography.
